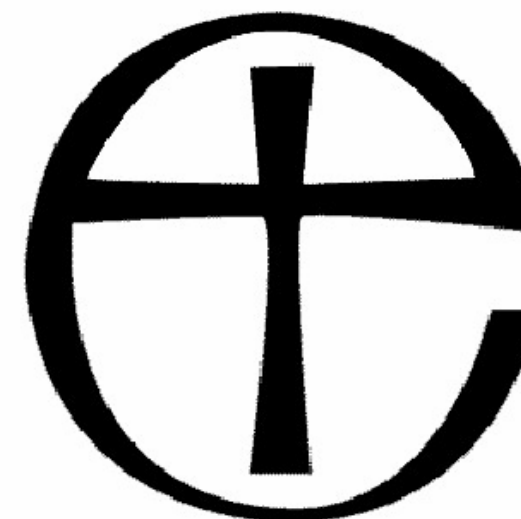

### **What's it all about ?**

Renewal of the Electoral Roll takes place in 2007 and every six years thereafter. In a year of renewal, no names are carried over from the old roll and everyone must make a new application to be included on the new roll.

Enrolment on the Electoral Roll gives us rights and responsibilities. Application should only be made if you are willing to make the commitment explained in this leaflet. We very much hope you will wish to do this.

### **What are my rights ?**

Enrolment entitles you to attend and vote at the Annual Parochial Church Meeting where elections take place for the Parochial Church Council and Parish Representatives on the Deanery Synod.

### **What are my responsibilities ?**

As a baptised member of the Church, to play a full part in its life and mission. What this involves is explained by our Archbishop's on the page opposite. The understanding of the Church of England is that those completing the application form overleaf are committing themselves to regular worship, financial giving and using their gifts and abilities to enable St. Nicholas & St. Barnabas Church to reach out for God with love and encouragement.
